



Volunteer Drivers

As a volunteer driver, you'll deliver nutritious meals and a couple minutes of connection with people who may be isolated or need assistance with their nutritional needs. Delivering good meals with a smile and a kind word is an easy and friendly way to make a real difference in our community.

What do I do?

Once a week, you'll pick up meals at a central location and deliver them on an assigned route. Each route may serve from 2 to 12 clients and can usually be completed in 1-2 hours.

As a driver, you're on the front lines of our mission. A brief conversation with a client can tell you a lot about their situation. If the client needs help or you feel something's a little off (e.g., client not answering, unusual circumstances), you'll call Mobile Meals staff immediately and they will take over to provide any needed additional help.

When and Where

Mobile Meals delivers meals Monday through Friday to homes Tucson, Sahuarita and Green Valley. You can choose the area that works best for you.

You'll pick up one or two insulated bags with pre-packaged meals at one of our distribution sites. Then you'll follow a route to deliver each meal to our clients' homes.

Permanent Drivers are assigned a weekly route. **Substitute Drivers** will be called to deliver various routes as needed.

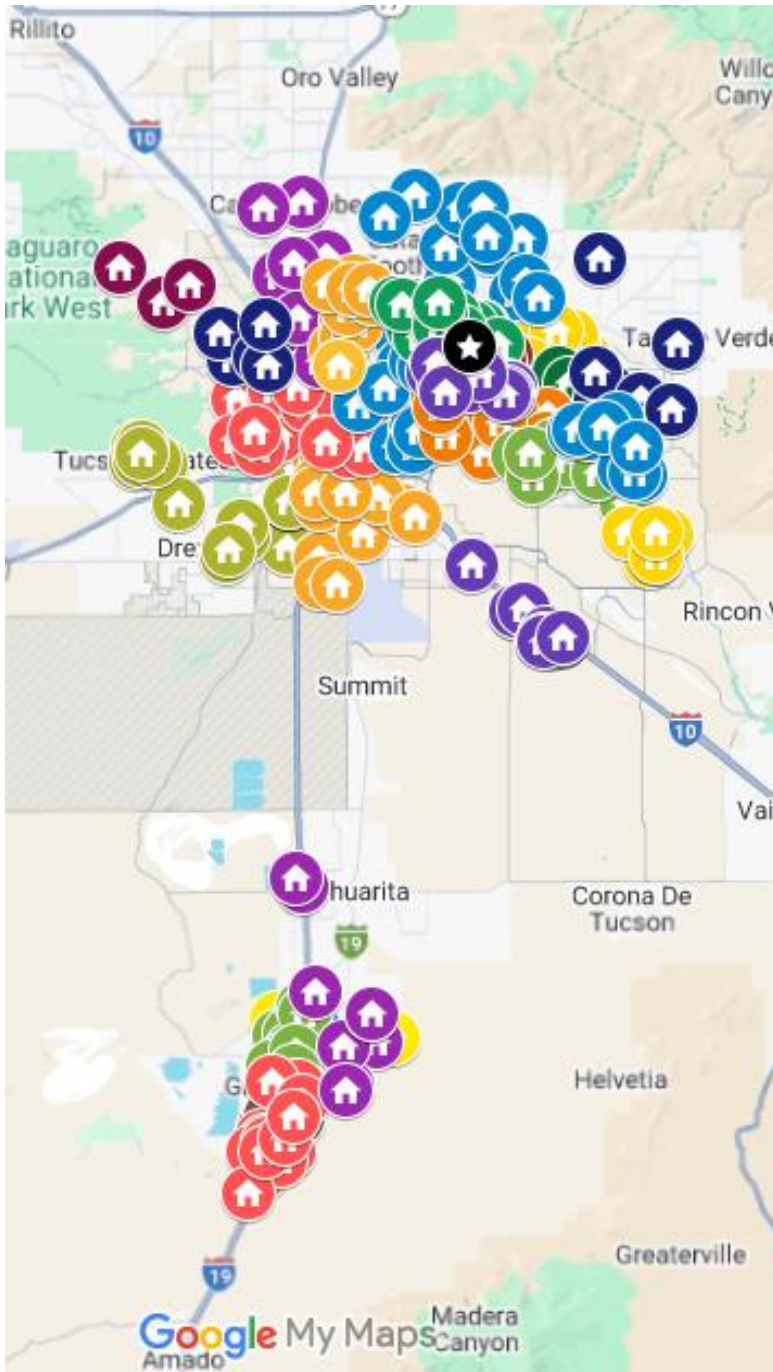
Qualifications

- Valid driver's license and a clean driving record & proof of current insurance.
- Access to a reliable vehicle with working air conditioning.
- Ability to lift and carry insulated meal bags (up to 20 lbs).
- Compassionate, dependable, and possesses good communication skills.

- Successfully complete a background check & over 18 years of age.
- Couple drivers welcome.
